FOR PARENTS • HOW TO USE THIS

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- 1 Facts first, as flashcards.**
Drill the facts as flashcards before written practice. Quick recall frees the brain for the harder problems instead of getting stuck counting.
- 2 Short timed drills build recall.**
A few minutes against a timer, a few times a week. Retrieving an answer from memory, not re-reading it, is what makes it stick. That is retrieval practice.
- 3 Space it out, don't cram.**
A little each day across a week beats one long session. Spaced practice is one of the most reliably effective study methods there is.
- 4 Ask 'how,' not just 'what.'**
On the harder ones, have your kid walk you through how they got it, not only the answer. Understanding the steps is what transfers to the next problem.
